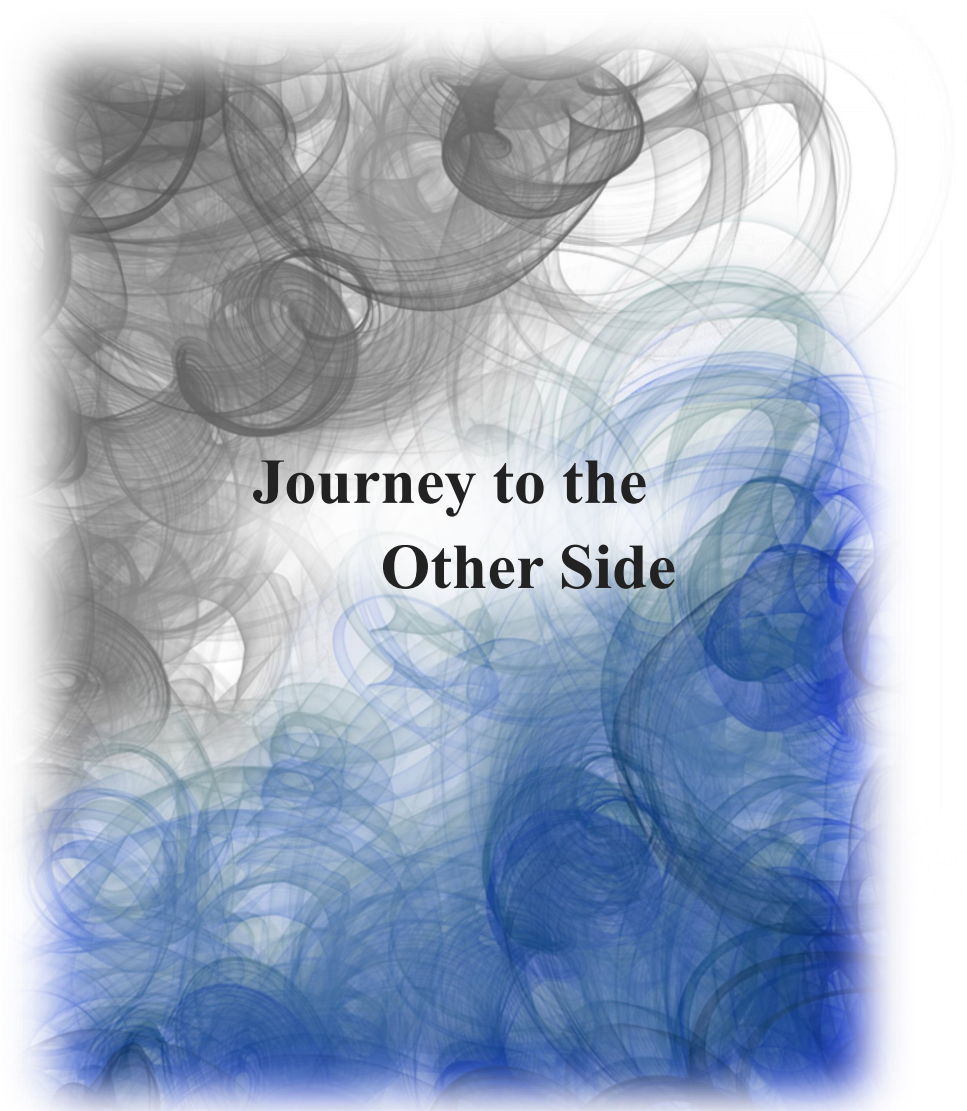
Jesus Calms the Storm
